



It's Time For Your Fire Doors to be Inspected!

Our records indicate it has been about a year since we last inspected and tested your fire doors. It is an important responsibility to make sure that the fire doors in your facility are properly maintained and can operate as intended in the event of a fire.

Per the requirements of the National Fire Protection Association, *NFPA 80 Standard for Fire Doors and Other Opening Protectives* (2010 edition), Chapter 5:

- Fire door assemblies shall be inspected and tested not less than annually
- Testing shall be performed by individuals with knowledge and understanding of the operating components (a trained door systems technician)
- A written record of the inspection shall be signed and kept for inspection by the AHJ (the local Authority Having Jurisdiction)
- Repairs shall be made, and defects that could interfere with operation shall be corrected without delay
- Fire doors that cannot be repaired or retrofitted must be replaced.

Annual inspection and testing is also mandated by Model Codes.

Lawrence Roll-Up Doors, Inc. can perform the necessary inspections and tests to allow you to be in compliance with those requirements:

- Visual inspection (all fire doors)
- Operational test (all fire doors)
- Drop test (rolling & sliding doors)

Should any damage be found or deficiencies determined, you will be advised of our findings and given the opportunity to correct them.

We will provide you with a detailed written Inspection and Test Form as your required documentation for the local AHJ.

A serialized Inspection and Test Record Label will also be attached to each fire door to indicate when that door was last inspected and tested.
